



This policy underscores the importance of honoring academic milestones, fostering a sense of pride and achievement in students, and marking their transitions with dignity and grace.

The school curriculum provides a comprehensive and progressive education framework designed to equip students with the skills and knowledge necessary for academic and personal success.

From Kindergarten (KG) to Grade VIII, the curriculum follows the international version of the Oxford University Press, ensuring global relevance and high academic standards. From Grade IX to Grade XII, the curriculum aligns with the Federal Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education (FBISE) Islamabad Pakistan standards.

Students graduate upon the successful completion of Grade XII. The educational journey is divided into four distinct phases, referred to as cycles:

- Cycle 1 comprises Kindergarten (KG)
- Cycle 2 includes Grades 1 to 4
- Cycle 3 encompasses Grades 5 to 8
- Cycle 4 covers Grades 9 to 12

Certification milestones are achieved at specific points in this progression. After completing Grade 10, students are awarded the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) by FBISE. Upon completing Grade 12, they receive the Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSSC), also issued by FBISE.

The school celebrates student accomplishments with two formal graduation ceremonies. The first is the Kindergarten Graduation Ceremony, held before or after the Final Exams of KG. This event marks the transition of students from Cycle 1 to Cycle 2 as they advance to Grade 1. It is a joyful and memorable occasion where students don graduation gowns and caps, receive certificates, and are acknowledged for their readiness to embark on the next phase of learning.

The second ceremony is the Grade 12 Graduation Ceremony, conducted at the end of the academic year. This formal event serves as a farewell to students as they prepare to move on to professional colleges and universities. Students wear graduation gowns and caps, receive their certificates, and are recognized for their academic and co-curricular achievements. This ceremony reflects the culmination of their school journey, celebrating their dedication and success while providing an opportunity for reflection and encouragement as they step into their future endeavors.
